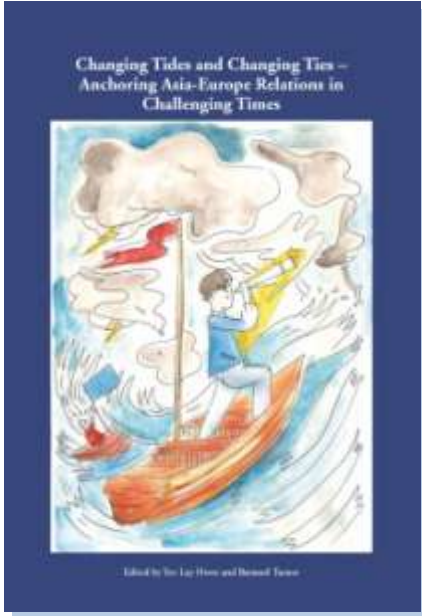


Book Launch and Presentation
